Afshar

The Afshar are a Turkic people group of around 400,000, living mainly in Iran, with smaller populations in Turkey and Afghanistan. **Historically nomadic**, many have now settled, though tribal identity continues to shape social structures and loyalty. Oral tradition, family honor, and heritage are highly valued.

Most Afshar in Iran follow Shia Islam, which is deeply intertwined with their cultural identity. Their communities are often tightly knit, making **outside influence difficult**. Access to the Gospel remains limited, especially in rural areas.

Less than 0.1% are Christians, and the Afshar are **considered unengaged**.
