Salar

The Salar are a Turkic Muslim minority of **about 130,000 people** living in China, known for their strong cultural cohesion and distinct language and traditions. Most are Sunni Muslims, and Islam shapes daily life, community structures, and identity. Mosques serve as central gathering places.

Their culture reflects Turkic roots alongside **Chinese and Tibetan influences**. Many Salar live in rural, close-knit communities, engaged in agriculture, animal husbandry, and small trade, with strong traditions of hospitality.

Government policies can restrict religious expression and outside influence. Access to the Gospel is extremely limited; there is **no known established church**, though a few believers attend Chinese churches in larger cities. Only 0.01% are Christians.
