## DAY 32: MAY 06

### Aynallu

The Aynallu are **a smaller Turkic tribal group** primarily found in central Iran and the Fars Province, with a population of around 100,000 people. Historically, they were nomadic herders, but most now live in settled rural communities. They are an Oghuz tribe, and their language is a dialect of Azerbaijani.

Their identity is shaped by tribal heritage and close family connections. Most follow Shia Islam, which is strongly integrated into daily life and tradition. Geographic spread and **limited outside engagement** contribute to their isolation, and their communities tend to be cautious toward external influences.

Christians make up **less than 0.01% of the population**, which would be fewer than about 10 people out of 100,000.
