Khoton

The Khoton are a small Turkic people group of **around 13,000 living in northwestern Mongolia**, mainly in the Altai region. Although they have Turkic roots, their culture has mixed with other Mongolian groups over time, including language.

They live a **nomadic pastoral life**, moving with their herds and living in portable yurts. Life is harsh and remote, and access to education and healthcare is limited. Community identity is very strong, and families tend to marry within the group.

The Khoton's religion is a curious **blend of Tibetan Buddhism (50%), Islam and folk religion**. Their isolation has helped preserve their culture but also makes access to the Gospel difficult. Christians make up only a small minority (about 0.1-2%).
